Editorial

The swing bridge at Piano Flat Northern Southland has been in the news lately. It was damaged in the floods February 2020. It has now been declared unsafe by and engineer, and is to be removed, not repaired. No word on whether it is to be replaced sometime in the future, but it's not to happen at present. This bridge has done good service to hunter's, tramper's, campers, and fishermen doing recreation on the Doc land in the Waikaia Valley.

Going by its appearance it is of NZ Forrest Service construction, most likely built in the 1970's? An organisation that was broken up when Doc was formed, its native bush and

associated scrub and grass land assets going into Doc. This was sold to us as an improvement!

This bridge should either be fixed up or replaced, but unfortunately recreation doesn't seem to be of much interest to Doc. They appear to be more interested in protecting Biodiversity. Thus restricting access can be very much the way to go.

There has been a lot of damage to tracks New Zealand wise with the weather problems the country has experienced of late, Doc still seem only interested in repairing the great walks type track, and retreating from other areas. This is the same attitude that was going to have them remove numbers of high country huts about 20 years ago now. Now a lot of these are maintained by volunteers.

There is some public interest in doing something about this bridge or another bridge there, as I write this.

No bridge is not going stop people crossing the river, which has its dangers. The citizens of this country have a right to access Doc land, it is theirs. They also have a right to access it safely. The Government needs to direct the Doc to use more of its funding for recreation. Not the crumbs it seems to get now. A third of the country is Doc land this is too much to be locked up to conserve its' unique Biodiversity.



Rifle (bolt out) + ammo – Up to and including .308/7.62 calibre

Bipod or other front support and rear support.

The range will be operated by a designated Rang Officer who will make themselves known at the range.

General format will be

Allocation of target frame

Validation of rifle being able to hit target at 100m

Shooting 200m and beyond after validation

Dates: The range is not for casual use but is available for use on the following dates: Currently over the Summer Range is available Sundays (except over Xmas) 11am to 1pm,100yards to 200 yards. After which there is a NRA style shoot at longer ranges Range fee is \$10.00
